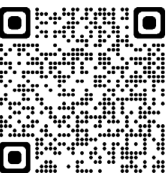
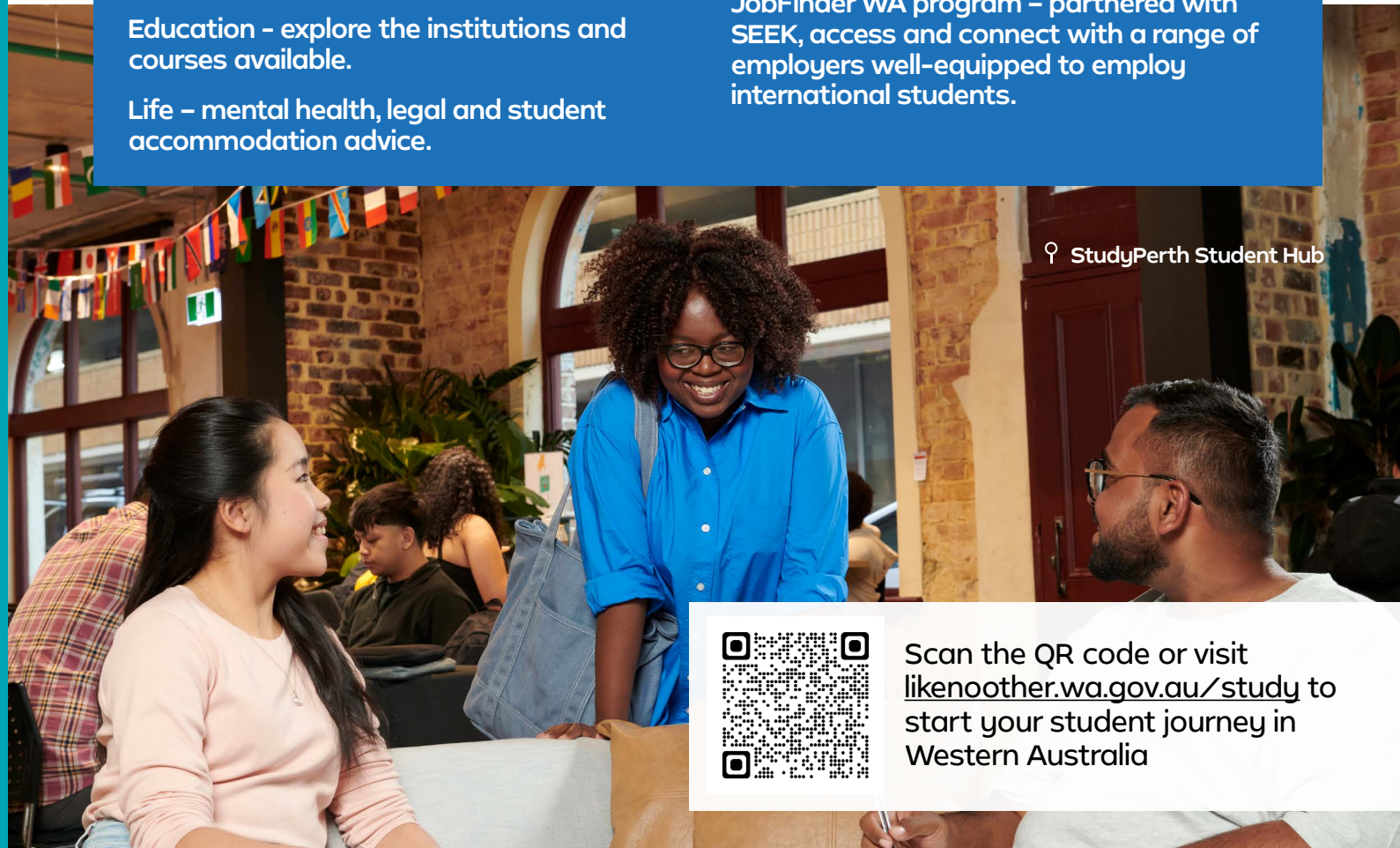

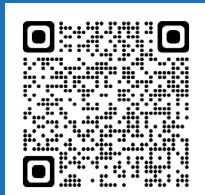

With a diverse range of job opportunities and world-leading programs connected to global industries, students gain professional experience before graduating to kick-start their future career.

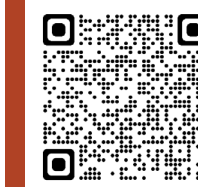


Experience a world-class education like no other
